NCS recommends individuals that are struggling with significant Psychiatric and/or behavioral functional limitations to seek services. Services provided through **NCS** accommodate both psychiatric and developmental disability populations. **NCS's** community-based services "Intensive in-home services" and "Mental Health Skill-building services" encourages and empower individuals and their families to productively maintain a healthy family unit, assist in reducing and/or eliminating chances of individuals being placed at-risk of being removed from the home and placed in a group home, hospital, or incarceration. **NCS** services children, adolescents, adults and their families within the central Virginia area.

NCS residential services provides long-term residential services to individuals with a developmental disability waiver. Our homes are coed service adults 18 to 85. Our homes are established with love, comfort, family-oriented, and individuality. Every individual will have the opportunity to have their independent rooms. Sharing a room is optional for the individual.

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Our Mission

Neighborhood Community Services (NCS) provides an integrated structure in which services promote healthy individuals & families. Our function is to assist individuals in sustaining their mental and behavioral health and eliminate substance use. **NCS** assists individuals in building a healthy lifestyle to increase their ability to become socially, emotionally, and intellectually independent through effective interventions, social interactions, skill-building, community engagement and community support.



Our Services

Residential Waiver Services

NCS, serves individuals ages 18 to 85 that have been diagnosed with a developmental disability. Dually diagnosed individuals are welcome. Our residential housing accommodates both male and female that needs residential supportive living. They will be housed in appropriate places based on specific developmental disability waiver criteria(s) and necessities. Our residential homes are in Central Virginia areas.

NCS residential homes provide daily supports and monitoring with adult daily life skills be educational reinforcements, community supports use of outside resources and a collaborative team approach.. Services and supports include, but are not limited to recreational supports, building motor skills, life skills, hygiene, developmental skill building, meal/nutritional preparation, and more.



Community Based Services

NCS community base services will utilize a collaborative approach that exploits the family's strengths, special skills, and abilities to successfully meet individuals' and their family's goal. A Community Practitioner is assigned based on the need and services of the individual and family. This approach provides a network of support that can assist individuals and their families in functioning effectively in the community and at home.

Intensive In-Home Services

Intensive In-home Services is an intensive, in-home and individualized mental health service that is a medical necessity for individuals with mental health disorders.

Intensive In-Home Services (IIHS) are time-limited, goal directed interventions focused on children and adolescents who have been diagnosed with a serious emotional disturbance. Those diagnosis may include but not limited to; mood and anxiety disorders, behavioral and conduct disorders, autistic spectrum disorders, personality disorders, depression, attention deficit hyperactivity disorder, attention deficit disorder, bipolar, oppositional defiant disorder.

IIHS treatment teams work both one-on-one with the child as well as with their families, to assist them in developing the skills to manage problematic behaviors more effectively.

Mental Health Skill-Building Services

Many of the issues we see affecting our children are birthed from mental health illness and behavioral disorders affecting the adults in their homes. Treating and supporting these adults is paramount to achieving wellness for the child and the family unit as one.

NCS employs specialized professionally trained Community Practitioners to provide training and support to adults with serious mental illness. Services include in-home assistance in personal daily living skills such as home maintenance and management, shopping, budgeting, medication management and parenting. In addition, we provide assistance to help maximize an individual's independence by assisting them in locating employment, continuing their education and in locating safe, stable and affordable housing.
